8. What is the consequence of refusing the daily cross of discipleship?
9. Explain “For whoever would save his life shall lose it” (v. 24).
10. Explain “but whosoever shall lose his life for My sake, the same shall save it” (v. 24).
11. Answer “For what is a man profited, if he gain the whole world, and lose or forfeit his own self?”
