what a kingdom citizen acts like. This sermon is largely considered to be the best sermon ever preached. So was Jesus' one-night gospel meeting a success?

In view of how many people heard the message, you would have to say it was a great success. However, just because there were a lot of people there to hear the message did not mean Jesus considered it to be a success.

At the end of the sermon Jesus puts everyone who listened to the sermon in one of two categories - the fools and the wise (**Mat 7:24-27**). Both the foolish people and the wise people among them took the day off to come hear Jesus preach God's message to them. Both groups heard Jesus proclaim the word of God to them. The difference between these two groups is if they acted on what was preached.

We were very well fed from God's word this past week by our brother Jason Hardin. The success of this gospel meeting depends on whether we are going to act on what God has told us to do or not. We have the great blessing of going to our website and listening to these sermons again as a reminder. If we don't act on these lessons, this gospel meeting can not be labeled successful.

As Jesus describes the wise man and the foolish man at the end of His sermon, He gives us great motivation to be like the wise man. The rain is going to come, the wind is going to blow, and the floods are going to rise up against us. The only way we will be able to withstand such forces trying to tear us down is if we act on God's word.
