- Paul's description of the Christian Life at the church in Thessalonica (1:3-4)
 - A Work of Faith and a Labor of Love
 - Having Patience with Hope in Jesus
 - Elected by God
 - See also 1 Peter 5:13

A Model Church

- •Consider 3 Parts of the Christian Life
 - Conversion (1:5-6)
 - Received the Word with Joy
 - Example (1:7-9)
 - Repentance and Proclamation
 - •*Hope* (1:10)
 - Obedient; Waiting for Jesus

Model Servants of God

- Paul and the other apostles set examples...
 - Pure in Motive (2:1-6)
 - Genuine in Love (2:7-12)
 - Resulting in Faith (2:13-16)
 - Joyful of Fruit (2:17-20)

A Model Brother is Sent

Timothy visits the Christians in Thessalonica.
Why does Paul Send him to them? (3:1-6)

- How does Paul find comfort while knowing afflictions, tribulations, and distress? (3:7-8)
 - See also Romans 5:3-5 and 1 Peter 1:5-7

The Model Walk

- Paul discusses God's requirements (4:1-12)
 - We Must Know God's Word
 - see also Col. 3:5-17 and Eph. 5
 - •We Must Have the Right Attitude
 - see also Eph. 4:1-3
 - We Must *Be Fruitful* in Every Good Work • see also Col. 1:10

The Model Walk (cont.)

- •Walking in light of the "Day of the Lord"
 - What will be the scene when Christ returns?
 - 1 Thess. 4:13-18
 - When will this happen?
 - 1 Thess. 5:1-2; Matt. 24:36
 - What is *the* role of the *waiting Christian*?
 - 1 Thess. 5:6-11; Matt. 26:41; Eph. 5:15-16

- Paul ends his letter with urgings, exhortations, and admonitions (5:12-22)
- •The instructions found in this letter apply to us today. Let's strive to model the Christian Life, and in doing, live out the Gospel as an example for others.
